And a country boy is all Ill ever be

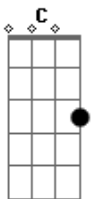

The red, the white, the blue

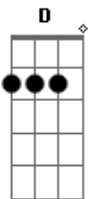

And a country boy is all I'll ever be

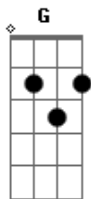
