 I'd still make it home for tea

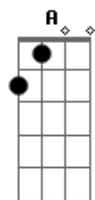

 The sky's no limit for me

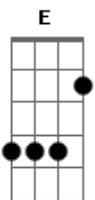

 And I can offer you the world for free

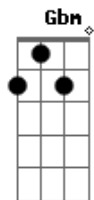
