- Ab**: 2nd fret, 1st string (G4), 2nd string (Ab4), 3rd string (Ab4), 4th string (D4), with a barre at the 2nd fret.
- Cn**: 3rd fret, 1st string (C4), 2nd string (C4), 3rd string (C4), 4th string (D4), with a barre at the 3rd fret.
- Fn7**: 3rd fret, 1st string (C4), 2nd string (F4), 3rd string (F4), 4th string (D4), with a barre at the 3rd fret.
- Bb7**: 2nd fret, 1st string (G4), 2nd string (Bb4), 3rd string (Bb4), 4th string (D4), with a barre at the 2nd fret.
- Cn7**: 3rd fret, 1st string (C4), 2nd string (C4), 3rd string (C4), 4th string (D4), with a barre at the 3rd fret.
