

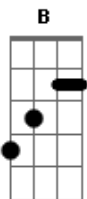

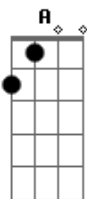

 Everything must cease

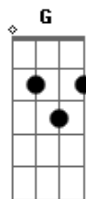

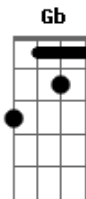
