 Cause I had a dream about a Rainbow, Rainbow Road

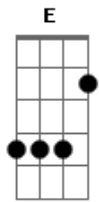
Then one day my chance came along

Sent me on my way to rain, Rainbow Road

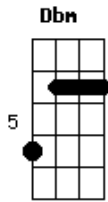
Then one night a man with a knife

 there is no dream about the rain, Rainbow Road

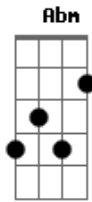
