If I got depression

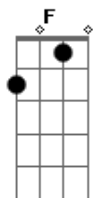
**F**

That's true

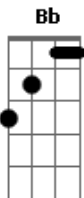
**Bb**

That's called progression

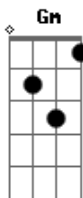

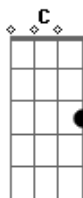

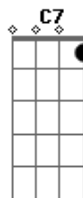
