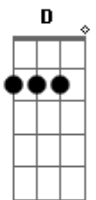

 It's so sad, so sad

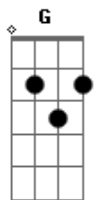

 (G G7 C F7 G D C D)

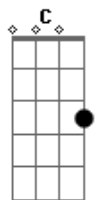
