 And somehow You use their words

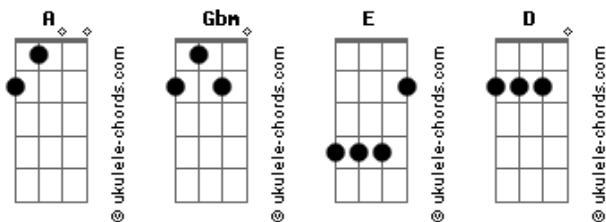
