When you touch me it always makes me shine

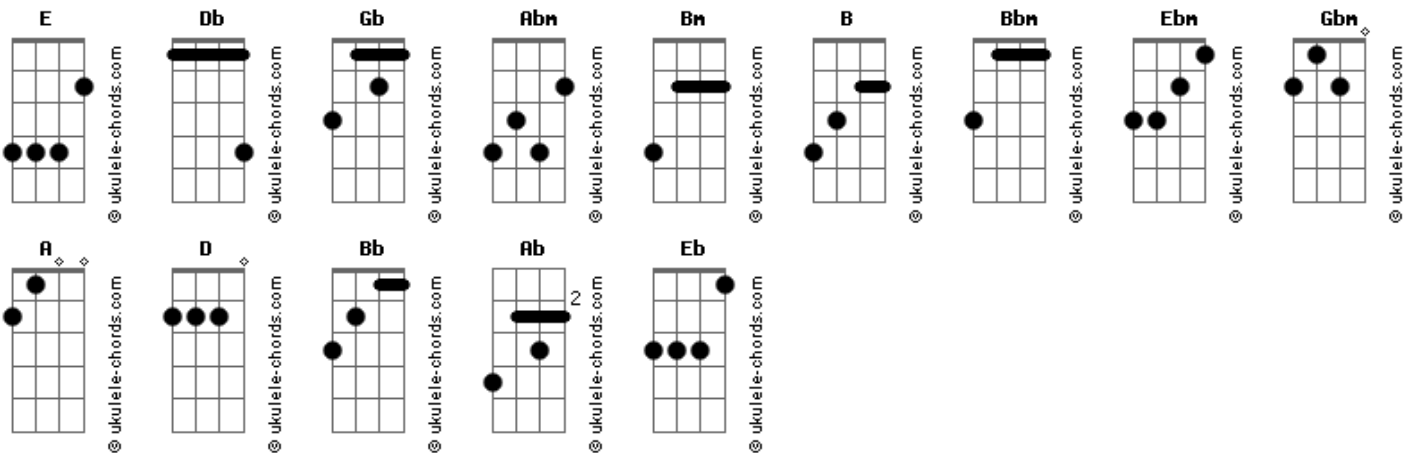
