- E7**: Fret 2 (E4, G4, B4, E5)
- A**: Fret 2 (A4, C5, E5, A4)
- Am**: Fret 1 (A4, C5, E5, A4)
- D7**: Barre at fret 2 (D4, F4, A4, D5)
- Am7**: Fret 1 (A4, C5, E5, A4)
- G**: Fret 3 (G4, B4, D5, G5)
- F**: Fret 1 (F4, A4, C5, F5)
- Dm7**: Fret 2 (D4, F4, A4, D5)
- E**: Fret 2 (E4, G4, B4, E5)
