For the life of a journeyman never changes

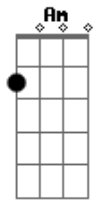

When it's you against yourself

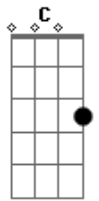

For the life of a journeyman never changes

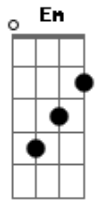
