- A**: String 1 at fret 2, string 2 at fret 2, string 3 at fret 2, string 4 at fret 2
- Gb**: Barre at fret 1, string 1 at fret 1, string 2 at fret 1, string 3 at fret 1, string 4 at fret 1
- B7**: Barre at fret 1, string 1 at fret 1, string 2 at fret 1, string 3 at fret 1, string 4 at fret 1
