Somewhere so high above this wall.

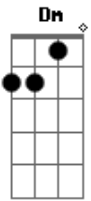

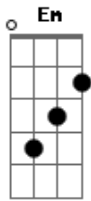

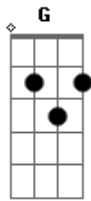
