(Db Bbm Db Bbm Db Bbm)

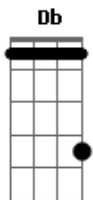

I think I'll join you in the ground

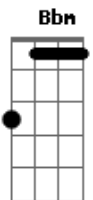
