

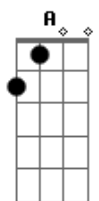
Disturbed - Sound Of Silence

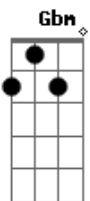
Gbm E

 And whispered in the sound of silence

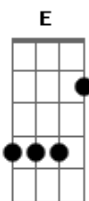

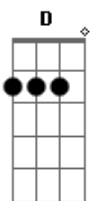
