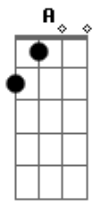

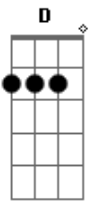

 Just leave me to despair

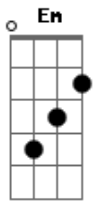

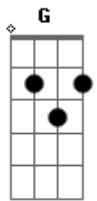
