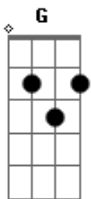

We'll applaud you with the sound that my hands make.

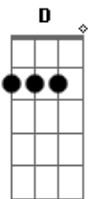

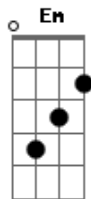

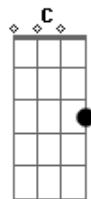
