Ignorando lo que se piense

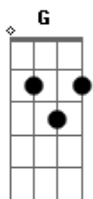
Había una almohada y un secreto en la habitación

Para ser exterminados

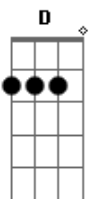
