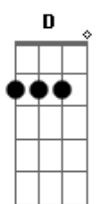

Made me sad to think it was dead

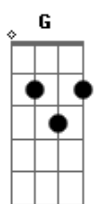

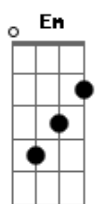
