 Notes: As in all the tab I do, there is NO timing, you need to listen and find out yourself, it's good for you.

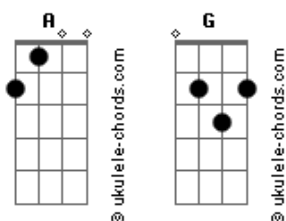
