Little children laughing at the boys and girl

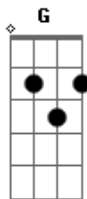
The meadow lark singing to you each and every day

The arclad on the hills and the market in the hay

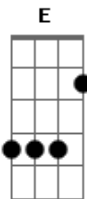
After this point, where the "oohs" come in, it is a combination of Gm chord and C chord (either sounds great) strumming, with this on the top, repeated:

The song ends on a G major chord.

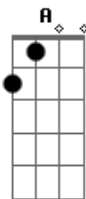
