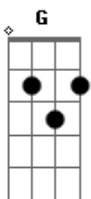

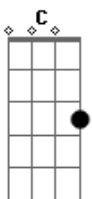

The youth you once possessed <sup>D</sup> <sup>G</sup>

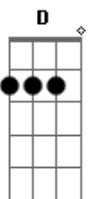
