(intro)-High gain a bit of reverb, high treble and bass, mid medium. opening **E** chord for a while. Pickscrapes lead to the main riff, which is a lot like Radiohead's 'sulk'.

(verse)-"Can you hear me?" repeat until chorus

(chorus) "Mine is yours and yours is mine"

"There is no Divide" rpt "I will Sacrifice"

"In Your Honour I would Die Tonight"
