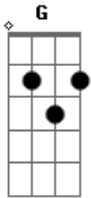

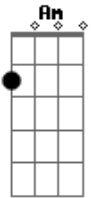

 But I get the feeling it doesn't see me

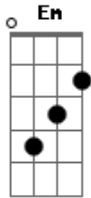
