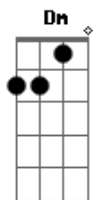

 On stage to end the play

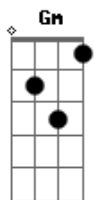

 When I was young

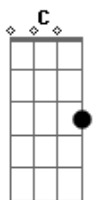
