Bridge: Once in a while I'd surf with you, our first band was called Fii I.M.R.U.

Then repeat chorus, playing a barred G-C-G instead of the (C)-(D)-G part at the end.

Next: repeat intro 2x, then lead guitar plays this while 2nd guitar plays a D with palm muting:

Last verse repeats the words from the first verse, except it's played with barre chords.

Riff: ("yeah just by trying. . .")
