Bb C F Bb

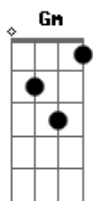
Blue, so blue, my love is burning blue.

Please, don't you forget how much I've lied.

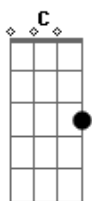
