 (Am G Em)

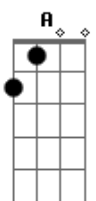
Come on and wrap me up, let me tilt you back and swim

 Trip over sidewalk blocks and slurred words, that I know aren?t even mine

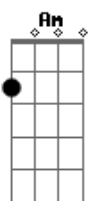
Jack?s a better friend than Jesse cause he puts the pain to ease

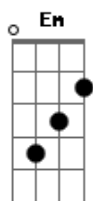

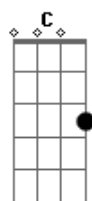

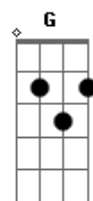
