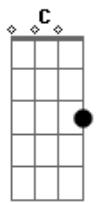

They are going through the unimaginable

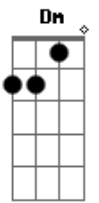

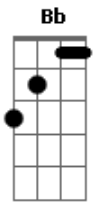

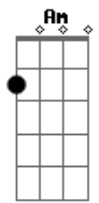
