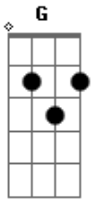

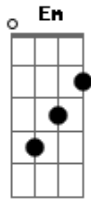

 One more time, I'm listening

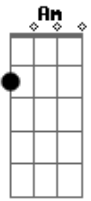

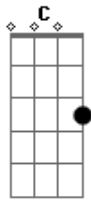

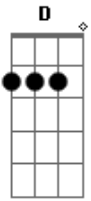
