(intro) (and verses)
(octaver and phaser i think)

(bridge)
(distortion)

(this is all harmonics- i cant find the right harmonic, but i know it sounds like the same note as when u play the ninth fret on the top-e string)

(try either)

A)

"..youre never gonna be.."

or **B**) Play harmonics on the **THIRD** fret of the low-**E** string. Near the end of the bridge just before the chorus, move up the neck while playing harmonics.

(chorus)
(distortion)

(#= palm-mute this chord)

"...should i appologise..."

(now play intro (second verse) followed by the bridge and then the chorus)

(mini-bridge between second verse and bridge)

(interlude)

It starts with more weird noises which mike plays. its hard to say what notes to play but i think its the open top **E** string and **B** string. Use phaser, delay and reverb (i havent a clue what mike uses but this is what i use).
