Dm7 **Bb** **C**

(Giant steps are what you take walking on the moon.....)

(bridge)

Bb **F** **C** **Gm**

Some may say I'm wishing my days away

Bb **F** **C** **Gm**

no way and if it's the price I pay

Bb **F** **C** **Gm**

some say tomorrow's another day

Bb **F** **C**

you stay I may as well play

Then play the same **Dm7**, **Bb** and **C** sequence to repeat and fade.

..and that's all there is to it!

(verse 1)

Giant steps are what you take walking on the moon
I hope my legs don't break walking on the moon
We could walk forever walking on the moon
We could be together walking on, walking on the moon

(verse 2)

Walking back from your house walking on the moon
Walking back from your house walking on the moon
Feet they hardly touch the ground walking on the moon
My feet don't hardly make no sound walking on, walking on the moon

(bridge)

No way and if it's the price I pay
Some say tomorrow's another day
You stay I may as well play

(verse 1)

After the bridge, then play and hold a **Dm7** for two more lines of the 'dum-da-dum' bass sequence, just as in the intro.

(repeat and fade)
