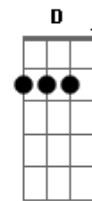
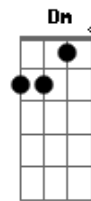
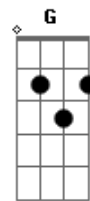
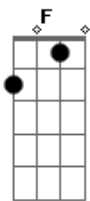
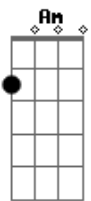
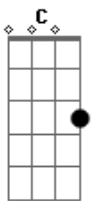
Look at the difference it makes
