when only yesterday you called me names

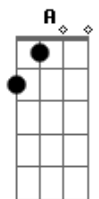
<sup>D</sup>

<sup>A</sup>

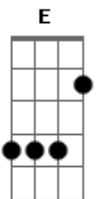
<sup>E</sup>

we're truly going to try to change

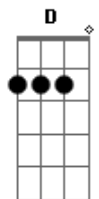
