when only yesterday you called me names

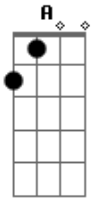

well they sure did feel ashamed

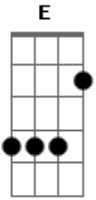

we're truly going to try to change

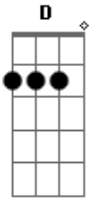
