just like it used to be.

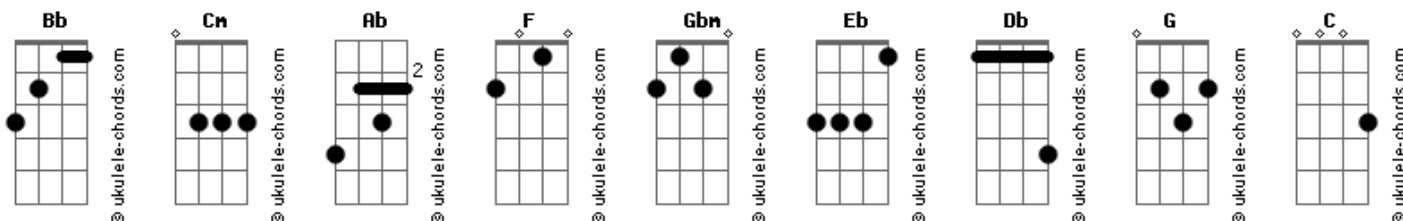
