 doo-dle ay ee

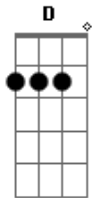

 Joyful and loving in letting it be

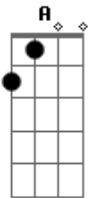

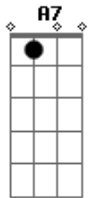

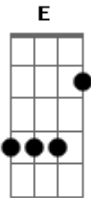
