One more time, let me kiss you.

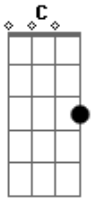

Dream about the days to come,

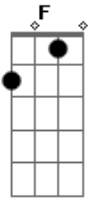

About the time I won't have to say . . .

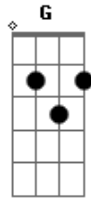

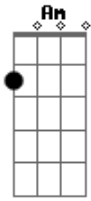
