One more time, let me kiss you.

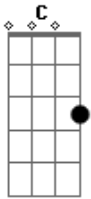

Dream about the days to come,

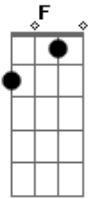

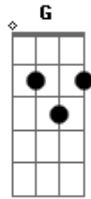

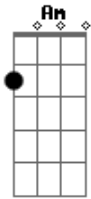
