The fields are all bare and the cotton won't grow

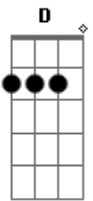
Me and my family gotta pack up and go

Where I'll make a livin' the Lord only knows but I'm Busted.

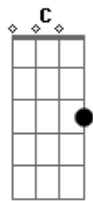
