 A A7 D in the sky, Lord, in the sky.

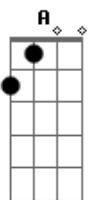

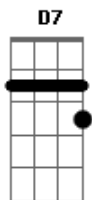

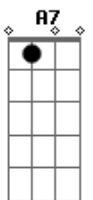
