 D leading your pet Trachadon ?

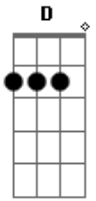

 A D play and tag with your Iguanodon !

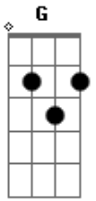

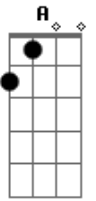
