leading your pet Trachadon ?

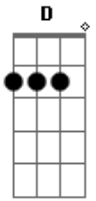

play and tag with your Iguanodon !

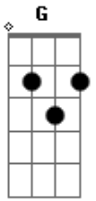

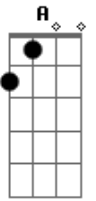
