<sup>E</sup> A prodigal returnin' to the girl in Saskatoon

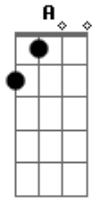

<sup>E</sup> I'm freezin' but I'm burnin' for the girl in Saskatoon

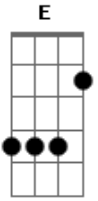
<sup>E</sup> But my journey was forgotten when I held her in my arms

<sup>E</sup> I found eternal spring with the girl in Saskatoon

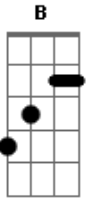

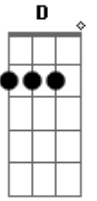
