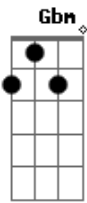

With a southern accent - where I come from.

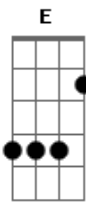

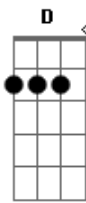

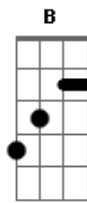
