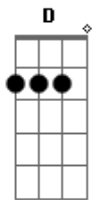
From the great atlantic ocean to the wide pacific shore

 Travelin through the jungle on the wabash cannonball

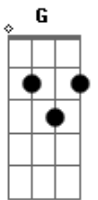
Well she came down from Birmingham one cold september day

 Sing Chorus

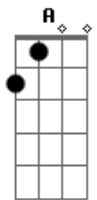
