 sake

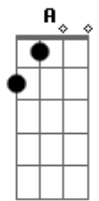
Snake **A7** Take me in oh tender woman sssssssighed the

 revived

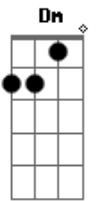
Chorus

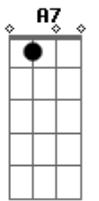
