- . - palm mute
- b - bend down
- ~ - vibrato
- \ - slide down
- / - slide up
- h - hammer on
- p - pull off
- t - tapping; note before this symbol is played with middle finger of your right hand
- = - tremolo (play the note before this sign as fast as you can)
- some effect, maybe it's wah-wah. It makes note 1 ot 2 octave higher

Tuning: tuned down half step.  
 Intro: backing

Intro: lead played with tapping.  
 I can't transcribe it precicely, but notes that you must tap on 1st string is following rhythm powerchords as you can see below:
