 Yeah, I know it gets tired only where are your friends tonight?<sup>D</sup>

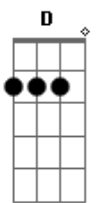
And to tell the truth<sup>A</sup>

 You think over and over, "hey, I'm finally dead."<sup>D</sup>

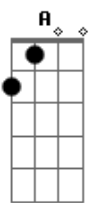
Oh, if the trip and the plan come apart in your hand<sup>A</sup>
