 Yeah, I know it gets tired only where are your friends tonight?^D

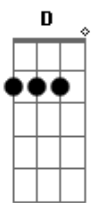
And to tell the truth^A

 You think over and over, "hey, I'm finally dead."^D

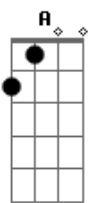
Oh, if the trip and the plan come apart in your hand^A
